About the project



- The project aims to develop the competencies of young people related to sustainable development goals, especially **SDG 5 - Gender Equality**.
- The project will deeply examine this SDG and its perspective, which will be combined with their local reality and will make the simulation of the United Nations General Assembly, where they will make the **resolution paper** of the problems they are facing in their countries and will find out the solutions to those problems.
- The project involves participants as the main organisers of the **local actions**, where they will try to solve the problems discussed by them. After those local actions, they will share the results **in the guidebook**.

Project is organized by youth organization **Gori Youth Center** (Georgia), in cooperation with youth organizations “**Yeghvard**” **Youth Ecological NGO** (Armenia) and **Bildungswerk Sachsen der Deutschen Gesellschaft e.V.**(Germany).

The project is funded under the grant program “MEET UP! Youth for Partnership” by the Remembrance, Responsibility and Future (EVZ) Foundation and the Federal Foreign Office..

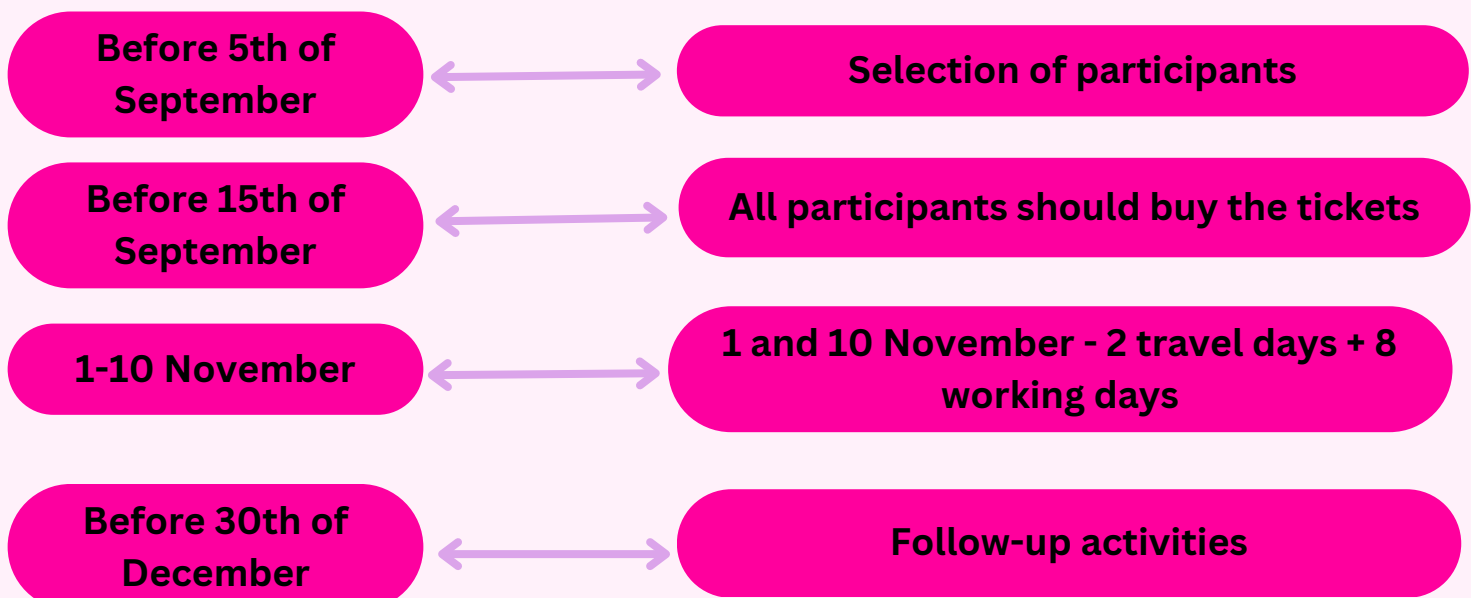
About the project

The objectives of the project:

1. To make Sustainable Development Goals, their meaning, and their idea familiar to the participants.
2. To raise awareness and develop the attitude of young participants especially related to gender equality as the SDG and its importance on the individual level.
3. To exchange the current situation between the developing and developed countries and to share the best practices of the actions on national levels.
4. To motivate and involve young people in taking action on a local and national level according to the targets and the indicators from United Union.
5. To create the intellectual outcomes - resolution paper and guidebook for young people related to SDG 5 "Gender Equality" and some offline (stickers) and online materials (vlogs, posters, memes, posts) for the project dissemination.

Participants' profile

There will be 8 participants + 1 project head + 1 facilitator per country.

The participants will be selected based on the main criteria:

- Aged between 18-35.
- Good command of English, both in writing and speaking.
- Motivation to be involved in all project phases, including the **preparation, residential meeting in Georgia and follow-ups***.
- To be a citizen or a resident of Armenia, Georgia, or Germany. Being a Youth Worker is an asset.

Briefly about the follow-up activities:

After the residential meeting, all participants must be involved in organising local actions, which they will plan during the residential visit. Those activities can be Workshops, performances, demonstrations, etc.



Gender balanced group - it is strongly recommended the composition of the national groups to be gender balanced.

Participants' Tasks

Before coming to Georgia, participants in national groups have to do some small tasks, such as searching for local practices related to Gender Equality/preparing the workshop.

Detailed information about the home tasks will be given to selected participants.

Venue

The training course will take place in Bakuriani, Georgia, one of the most popular ski resorts. With its breathtaking mountains and nature, it is popular all year.

During the training course, the participants will stay in Hotel Grand Noel and will be in shared rooms (3 people in one room).

Accommodation and meals (3 courses + 2 coffee breaks a day)



Travel costs:

All travel costs will be reimbursed upon sufficient receipts, tickets, boarding passes and invoices. The reimbursement will be done after the training course, after being involved in follow-up activities.

If the participant will not be involved in organising follow-up activities, the organiser has the right not to reimburse the travel costs.

The reimbursement limit depends on your country:



Germany - up to 500 Euros per participant



Armenia - up to 80 Euros per participant

Tips before you purchase the tickets:

- 1. It is recommended to buy the tickets in Euros.*
- 2. Save the tickets, boarding passes, invoices. In case you will not have them, we will not be able to reimburse you.*
- 3. Don't buy the tickets until you receive confirmation from us.*
- 4. You can arrive in Tbilisi or Kutaisi international airports.*
- 5. Only the most economical ways of travel will be reimbursed.*

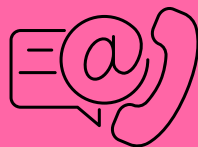
How to apply?
